#### OLD BUSINESS

- Finance committee will make a recommendation to the Vestry on their option of choice for the buyout of the lease for the Ark trailers.
- Tom Stevens will be responsible for heading the project of procuring a new church sign for the town church. Larry moved; Seth seconded to move the original sign to the Cox Street side and also up to \$1,000 can be spent on a new sign.
- It was suggested that at each Vestry meeting, one Vestry liaison, would report back to the group, an update on their ministry (the chairperson of that ministry may also be invited). Matt Wolinski will discuss stewardship at the next meeting. Norene Taylor will be invited also.
- HIV testing (done by Aids Delaware) will begin this Saturday from 9 am-noon. The testing will be done the second and fourth Saturday's of each month.
